"I am directed to say that instances have come to notice in which applications were made simultaneously for seeking approval of the Central Government under the proviso to section 297(1) of the Companies Act, 1956 as well as under other provisions viz, section 269 or section 294AA or section 314(1B) of the Act in respect of same contracts/transactions. The need for according approval under both the sections of the Act has been examined in the Department.

A circular resolution is a documented resolution which is signed by a company's directors, with wording to signify they are in favour of the resolution. Typically, companies which have a constitution will have a rule enabling them to use a circular resolution as a substitute for a resolution passed at a convened director's meeting.

Section 297 and 299 of the Companies Act, 1956. The Directors occupy a fiduciary position in relation to a Company. They must act bona fide and in the interest of the Company. This duty of good faith which fiduciary relationship imposes is identical with those imposed on trustees.

MCA issues clarification on transitional period for resolutions passed under the Companies Act, 1956. This transitional arrangement will be available upto expiry of one year from the passing of the resolution or six months from the commencement of the corresponding provision in 2013 Act, whichever is later. Further any amendment of the resolution must be in accordance with the relevant provision of the New Act.

(1) 2 As soon as may be after the commencement of the Companies (Amendment) Act, 1988 , the Central Government shall, by notification in the Official Gazette, constitute a Board to be called the Board of Company Law Administration.
